Recommended Actions:

That the Board of Supervisors:

- a) Accept a donation of \$17,623 from the SET Foundation, a 501(c)(3) organization; and
- b) Approve Budget Journal Entry #0006186 recognizing the donation; and
- c) Find that the proposed action does not constitute a "project" under the California Environmental Quality Act because it is within the exception provided by 14 CCR 15378(b)(4) for "the creation of government funding mechanisms or other government fiscal activities, which do not involve any commitment to any specific project which may result in a potentially significant physical impact on the environment."

Summary Text:

The SET Foundation, a 501(c)(3) organization, wishes to donate \$17,623 to the Sheriff's Office as follows: \$17,623 is designated for the Sheriff's Office Motor Unit to purchase five (5) sets of motorcycle officer safety uniforms, designed to provide additional protection to a motorcycle officer in the event of a collision. The Sheriff recommends that the Board of Supervisors accept this donation pursuant to section 25355 of the Government Code, section 18944 of title 2 of the California Code of Regulations, and section 610-D4.1 of the County Administrative Manual.

Background:

The SET Foundation, a non-profit organization not affiliated with the County of Santa Barbara, received donations to purchase motorcycle officer safety uniforms for the five (5) motorcycle officers employed by the Sheriff's Office. The SET Foundation ordered and received the uniform equipment from MotoPort USA, based in San Marcos, CA. The uniform equipment is designed to appear similar to a regular Sheriff's Deputy uniform, but is constructed of materials and padding that will protect the officer in the event of a collision in which he/she is ejected from the motorcycle. These uniforms will replace the uniforms currently worn by motorcycle officers, which are constructed primarily of cotton and polyester, and provide little to no protection in the event of a collision. The Sheriff is very grateful for donations made to the Sheriff's Office that provide for the overall safety of deputies who ride patrol motorcycles on a regular basis.

The SET Foundation is a California Non-Profit Public Benefit Corporation organized for charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. County policy D4.1 provides that donations of \$10,000 or more are to be accepted by the Board of Supervisors.
