The Santa Barbara County Health Center Board (HCB) is required pursuant to 42 USC § 254b and is established pursuant to the provisions of County Code Chapter 2, Article XVII, Health Center Board and the Co-Applicant Agreement between the Board of Supervisors and the Health Center Board. At the time the Co-Applicant Agreement was ratified in September 2015, the Board of Supervisors requested an Annual Report from the HCB as to the year's activities.

### **Background:**

The current version of the Santa Barbara County Health Center Co-Applicant Agreement was ratified by the Board of Supervisors and HCB in September 2015 and amended in 2019. The Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA), the federal agency responsible for the Federally Qualified Health

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Center program nationwide, approved the county's Co-Applicant Agreement in January 2016 and February 2019.
