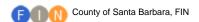

Therefore, the Sheriff's Office did not budget for any revenue and corresponding increase in fund balance. Fiscal year to date, the Sheriff's Office has received \$195,760 in State asset forfeiture funds that need to be recognized and placed in fund balance.
