The purpose of this addendum is to (1) correct an inadvertent omission in Section 35-142.7.5.a and make a minor addition to Section 35-142.8.1.e of Suggested Modification No. 1, and (2) attach one letter of public correspondence received to-date regarding the subject amendment (see Correspondence packet for copies of correspondence received).

1. CHANGES TO SUGGESTED MODIFICATION NO. 1

a. Correction to Section 35-142.7.5.a of Suggested Modification No. 1

The following correction to Section 35-142.7.5.a is made to show the suggested modification versus the County's proposed language. Language recommended by Commission staff to be inserted is shown in <u>double underlined</u>:

a. All development associated with the construction of an accessory dwelling unit shall be located in compliance with the requirements of Section 35-97 (ESH – Environmentally Sensitive Habitat Area Overlay District) and all applicable ESH policies and provisions of the certified Local Coastal Program.

b. Addition to Section 35-142.8.1.e of Suggested Modification No. 1

The following addition to Section 35-142.8.1.e is made is at the request of Santa Barbara County for clarification purposes. Language to be inserted is **bold double underlined**:

e. Nonconforming Accessory Buildings. An accessory dwelling unit located entirely or partially within a nonconforming accessory building may be allowed in compliance with Section 35-162 (Nonconforming Buildings and Structures); however, accessory dwelling units are not allowed within a nonconforming accessory building if the nonconforming accessory building is inconsistent with any of the coastal resource

<u>protection policies or **coastal resource protection** development standards of the certified Local Coastal Program.</u>
