RE:

Consider recommendations regarding Gypsy Canyon Creek Bank and Road Repair Emergency Permit, Case No. 19EMP-00000-00002, Lompoc Area, Fourth District, as follows:

- a) Receive and file a report on the Gypsy Canyon Creek Bank and Road Repair Emergency Permit, which authorized the repair of an eroded paved road, road bed, culvert, and adjacent creek bank;
- b) Determine that issuance of the emergency permit is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15269(b), as this action was an emergency repair to a road in order to maintain public safety and welfare; and
- c) Determine that receiving and filing the report is not a project pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15378(b)(5), as it is an administrative government activity that will not result in direct or indirect physical changes in the environment.
