## **Facility Tipping Fees**

Franchised trash & recyclable tip fees increasing \$102 to \$150/ton at all County facilities

Increase pre-approved by BOS (and other participating jurisdictions) to finance the ReSource Center at the Tajiguas Landfill

Future franchise tip fees are projected to increase annually by 3.5%

Self-haul trash & other tip fees adjusted mainly by CPI



## **Redefining Waste Recovery**

- Materials Recovery Facility (MRF)
  - Process mixed & source separated waste
  - Recover recyclables
- Anaerobic Digestion Facility (ADF)
  - Process organics from mixed and source separated waste
- Allows region to meet all state mandates
- Recovers for markets up to 60,000 tons/year out of trash
- Largely energy self sufficient



# **Cuyama Valley Parcel Fees**

Assessed on annual property tax


Pays for operation of New Cuyama & Ventucopa transfer stations

Fee of \$77 per single family dwelling

Staff recommends no change in fee




### Franchised Hauler Collection Rates





#### Collection Rates Driven by 3 Components

- 1. Collection component most variable
  - Subject to annual CPI adjustment
  - 2.5% this year
- 2. Facility fee component affected by tipping fee changes
  - 47% increase on South Coast for trash & recyclables
  - 33% increase in North County for recyclables
- 3. Solid Waste Program Fee component
  - Fee being lowered from12% to 11%



## **Average Residential Rate Impact**

Area Served	% Increase
South Coast & Santa Ynez unincorporated	11-18% (avg. \$5.80 increase for ReSource Center, remaining \$.94 is other factors)
Lompoc & Santa Maria unincorporated	4-6% (avg. \$1.28 increase for recycling, remaining \$.28 is other factors)

## **Average Commercial Rate Impact**

Area Served	% Increase
South Coast & Santa Ynez unincorporated	13-20% (85% of increase for ReSource Center)
Lompoc & Santa Maria unincorporated	1%
