Recommended Actions:

Consider recommendations regarding Contractors on Payroll for psychiatric services as follows:

- 1. Approve and authorize the Chair to execute an amendment to the Contractor on Payroll agreement with Kellee Clougherty, M.D., reducing the amount by \$60,360 for a new contract maximum amount of \$126,840 for the period of July 1, 2009 to June 30, 2010.
- 2. Approve and authorize the Chair to execute an amendment to the Contractor on Payroll agreement with Herman Schornstein, M.D., increasing the amount by \$59,510 for a new contract maximum amount of \$105,270 for the period of July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010.
- 3. Approve and authorize the Chair to execute a Contractor on Payroll agreement with Angeline De Guzman, M.D., in an amount not to exceed \$47,840 for the period of January 1, 2010 through June 30, 2010.
- 4. Authorize the Director of ADMHS to approve amendments to the proposed contracts, provided any such amendments do not exceed ten percent (10%) of the contract's dollar amount.

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Summary Text:

Dr. Clougherty provides psychiatric services to youth and their families at the Santa Barbara Children's Clinic. Dr. Schornstein provides psychiatrist services at Alcohol, Drug and Mental Health Services (ADMHS) outpatient clinics. Dr. De Guzman will provide psychiatric services to youth at the Santa Barbara County Juvenile Hall in Santa Maria. These contracts comply with the Santa Barbara County Contractor on Payroll Policy approved by the Board of Supervisors on October 3, 2006 and have received the concurrence of the CEO/Human Resources Office. Approval of these contracts will continue the psychiatric services provided at the Santa Barbara Children's Clinic, Calle Real Clinic, and Santa Barbara County Juvenile Hall.

Background:

The Contractors on Payroll listed below provide psychiatric services to adults and children, including development, review, revision, and approval of client assessments, evaluations and treatment plans; prescription and administration of psychiatric medications, as needed; assistance to clients with symptom management and development of personal coping skills; medication education for clients and families; and training, education and support to ADMHS staff and multi-disciplinary team members. ADMHS has experienced continuing difficulty recruiting and retaining certain key staff, particularly, psychiatrists, to the area. Contractors on Payroll have helped to bridge the gap to provide needed mental health treatment capacity.

Kellee Clougherty, M.D.

Dr. Clougherty provides psychiatric services to youth and their families at the Santa Barbara Children's Clinic. Dr. Clougherty's contract is being reduced to accommodate her reduced availability this fiscal year.

Herman Schornstein, M.D.

Dr. Schornstein provides psychiatric services to clients of the ADMHS Calle Real Clinic. The increase is necessary to provide backup coverage to youth and their families at the Santa Barbara Children's Clinic, due to Dr. Clougherty's reduced availability.

Angeline De Guzman, M.D.

Dr. Angeline De Guzman will provide psychiatric services to minors with mental illness who are in the custody of the Santa Barbara County Juvenile Hall, located in Santa Maria.

Performance Measure:

Approval of the recommended action will help ADMHS meet Recurring Performance Measure 0230 to provide effective mental health care for 5,200 seriously mentally ill adults and Recurring Performance Measure 0231 to provide mental health services to 3,000 youth with emotional disturbances and their families.
