Accept the Notice of Completion for work performed by the Contractor, Granite Construction Company. (a local vendor with an office in Santa Barbara), Post Office Box 50085, Watsonville, CA 95077, (Clerk to Record).

Summary Text:

Eight bridges, located in the unincorporated areas of Santa Barbara County, received rehabilitation treatments to increase bridge longevity. Work included sealing cracks with Methacrylate Resin, repairing concrete spalls, resurfacing with polyester concrete to repair damaged decks, cleaning and repairing joint seals, and fixing bridge approach paving. Project locations are attached for your information.

The Director of Public Works accepted this project as complete on October 23, 2009. The project was completed on time and on budget.

On February 17, 2009, the Board of Supervisors authorized the Director of Public Works, to advertise for construction bids for the 2009 American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA), and approved
