Custody Operations Policy 210. Truth Act (ICE)

PURPOSE: To set guidelines for compliance with Assembly Bill No. 2792, the Truth Act, effective January 1, 2017 within County Sheriff's Office jail facilities and for those persons having legitimate business within the Custody Operations branch.

POLICY: The Santa Barbara County Sheriff's Office prohibits discrimination against persons due to immigration status. The Santa Barbara County Sheriff's Office adheres to applicable federal and state laws, regulations and guidelines by providing notification to inmates of communication between the Department of Homeland Security, Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) and County Jail staff for the purpose of deportation and/or detention by ICE agents upon completion of commitments of incarceration.

ICE ACCESS INFORMATION - 2018

- Note on Data Collection: Historically, the Sheriff's Office has not maintained public records on aggregate ICE "access" data. All data provided herein resulted from manual staff research on individual booking packets.
- In 2018, the Values Act (SB 54) became law and changed certain aspects of the Truth Act.


