- b) Approve the plans for the Maria Ygnacio Creek Main Branch Future Post-Fire Mitigation Debris Rack, included as Attachment B; and

Summary Text:

This item is on the agenda in order to obtain Board approval and authorization to execute the Statement of Final Quantities (SFQ) for the Maria Ygnacio Creek Main Branch and East Branch Debris Basin Modification Project (Attachment A) and to obtain Board approval of the plans for the Maria Ygnacio Creek Main Branch Future Post-Fire Mitigation Debris Rack (Attachment B).

On May 14, 2019, the Board entered into an agreement with Union Engineering Company to construct the Maria Ygnacio Creek, Main Branch and East Branch Debris Basin Modification Project in the amount of \$755,893 including supplemental work authorized in the amount of \$30,000, plus contingency authorized in the amount of \$50,294.65, for a total authorized amount of \$806,187.65. This project was completed at a cost of \$687,449.76.

The Flood Control District has accepted the work of the contractor Union Engineering Company, and on September 10, 2019, the Notice of Completion for this project was recorded by the Clerk Recorder's office.

The Maria Ygnacio Creek Main Branch Future Post-Fire Mitigation Debris Rack Plans will be placed on standby to be activated in the event of a fire in the watershed.

Background:

On June 6, 2017 your board adopted a revised Debris Basin Maintenance and Removal Plan that includes modification of several of the South Coast Debris Basins. This Plan was required as a part of permit conditions included in the most recent long-term maintenance permit issued by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps), with fisheries conditions included by the National Marine Fisheries Service (NMFS).

The Maria Ygnacio Debris Basins were installed on the East Branch and Main Branch of Maria Ygnacio Creek following the Painted Cave Fire in 1990. Prior to the fire, no debris basins existed on these creeks. Modification of the basins allows compliance with our federal permits, yet retains the ability for post-fire operations.

The District was required to deconstruct the Main Branch Basin dam, and has reestablished the East Branch creek into its original drainage course around the existing East Branch Debris Basin, and has reconstructed the creek beds to mimic pre-basin geomorphology. The basin locations are shown in Exhibit A. These basins, as with many other basins on the South Coast, were established after wild fires and were intended to serve as protection following fires. If the watersheds burn in the future, Maria Ygnacio East Branch Creek will be routed back through the basin and the Main Branch Basin will be restored to its function by placing a debris rack at the dam site to trap debris as indicated with the Maria Ygnacio Creek Main Branch Future Post-Fire Mitigation Debris Rack Plans. These modifications will stay in place until the watershed recovers. On April 5, 2016, the Board approved and authorized the Public Works Director to accept and execute a grant agreement to receive grant monies for this project in the amount of \$231,662 by the Department of Water Resources (DWR) Urban Streams Restoration Program (USRP). Approximately \$218,000 of these funds will be applied to construction costs. The balance of this funding was used for design costs.
