Summary Text:

The Laguna County Sanitation District (District) provides wastewater services for the Orcutt and unincorporated Santa Maria area. New development is conditioned to design and construct sewer system facilities that will be dedicated to the District for ownership and maintenance purposes. Design standards and development policies are adopted and periodically updated to reflect changes in standards, regulations, conditions and policy for these facilities. This action updates standards last adopted in 2014.

Background:

Laguna County Sanitation District currently owns and operates approximately 128 miles of sewer lines and one lift station. Nearly all of this infrastructure was designed and constructed by development. The proposed *Laguna County Sanitation District Engineering Design Standards* updates design and construction specifications for new development as well as policies and procedures regarding annexation, conditions of approval, and incorporates new ordinances. The design standards and development conditions apply to development located in the Laguna County Sanitation District service area and territory that may be annexed to the District's service area. This action updates and replaces the *Laguna County Sanitation District Standard Specifications for the Construction of Sanitary Sewers* last adopted in 2014.

Performance Measure:

This action updates standardized drawings, engineering design principles, incorporates development conditions and policies and procedures for new development in the Laguna County Sanitation District service area.

Fiscal and Facilities Impacts:

Facilities to be constructed by development will meet updated standards and policy.
