Justification: This budget revision will amend the Public Health Department Public Health Fund for unanticipated revenue from CDC through the California Department of

Public Health (CDPH) Public Health Emergency Preparedness Office (PHEP) as part of the federal government's emergency funding package signed into law on February 28, 2020. The Public Health Department (PHD) was notified that it would receive \$458,612 in funding through the State allocated from the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) for public health-related COVID -19 response. The PHD will need to submit a formal budget and workplan for the funds, but is moving quickly to amend the budget to provide appropriations to ramp up its Public Health Laboratory testing ability for Tier 1 testing of suspect cases (\$95,000 for test kits and other supplies and courier services), Enhanced public information tools and website (\$35,000), PHD Department Operations Center (DOC) response costs (\$168,612), Assistant Health Officer and other contractor costs (\$100,000), Case isolation costs (\$35,000), and personal protection

equipment (\$25,000).
