AEDs LCPA Certification Process

December 11, 2018 **Board adoption** February 13, 2020 CCC conditional certification April 7, 2020 Board accepts conditional certification May 2020 CCC final certification

Suggested Modification #1

- Updates lists of permitted uses to reflect changes from the ADU and Cannabis LCPAs.
 - Cannabis and ADU LCPAs certified late 2018 and early 2019
 - AED ordinance amendments adopted late 2018
 - Ensures language from ADU and Cannabis LCPAs not inadvertently deleted from Article II

Suggested Modification #2

- Clarifies permitting and processing requirements for AEDs, including principal permitted uses (PPUs) and non-principal permitted uses (non-PPUs)
- Clarifies that AEDs are allowed in other zones where SFDs are allowed
- Clarifies that a Development Plan may be required

Suggested Modification #3 & 4

- Revises findings to require that all AEDs be "sited and designed to avoid all prime agricultural soils and non-prime land suitable for agriculture to the maximum extent feasible and ... maintain the long-term viability of productivity of ... agricultural resources and operations on the property and on adjacent agricultural lands."
 - Consistent with existing ag resource protection policies of CLUP and Coastal Act

Suggested Modification #5

- Updates AED permit requirements in Table 18-2 (Gaviota Coast Plan Overlay)
 - Gaviota Coast Plan LCPA certified November 2018
 - Suggested Mod. #5 contains minor changes to reflect new permit levels proposed by AED LCPA

Environmental Review

- Negative Declaration adopted for 2015-2023
 Housing Element (14NGD-00014)
 - Fulfills environmental review requirements for AED ordinance amendments
- Public Resources Code § 21080.9 and CEQA
 Guidelines § 15265
 - Exempts preparation and adoption of LCP

Recommended Actions

- a) Receive notice of the Coastal Commission's conditional certification with five suggested modifications
- b) Adopt a resolution accepting the Coastal Commission's conditional certification
- c) Determine project is not subject to CEQA
- d) Direct P&D to transmit the adopted resolution to the Coastal Commission
