## SUBJECT: Assisted Outpatient Treatment Program (AOT) funding

The Santa Barbara League of Women Voters of Santa Barbara (League) has strongly supported the County's Assisted Outpatient Treatment (AOT) program since its inception. AOT fills a gap in the mental health continuum of care, mandating outpatient treatment for those in our community suffering the most serious illness. The AOT program has reduced crisis events, incarcerations and homelessness for a significant number of persons in the pilot program.

We reviewed the Department of Behavioral Wellness' budget presentation. The League commends Director Alice Gleghorn for listing AOT Implementation among the Department's 2020-21 Objectives and for the success of the pilot program.

We urge you to provide funding for continuation of the AOT program. We cannot afford to lose it.
