In these difficult times, we urge you to maintain the highest possible levels of support for all of our county libraries. Like many, our Carpinteria library is vital to our high percentage of community members who do not have computers or wifi at home. When libraries and schools reopen and residents are able to go back to work, libraries will provide even more critical help to those desperately seeking job information and tech support.

How ironic it is that along the current health and economic crises, the past year has also brought promising new developments for the future of our county libraries. The Library Advisory Committee and its Ad Hoc committees have worked tirelessly (even in recent chaotic weeks) to craft benchmarks for basic small library services and identify costs for these services.
