The purpose of this memo is to inform the Board of Supervisors of the Applicant's withdrawal of Land Use Permit (Case No.18LUP-00000-00351) associated with Departmental Agenda Item No. 4 (Santa Rita Valley Ag., Inc. Cannabis Cultivation Appeal) from the Board of Supervisors agenda of April 21, 2020. The Applicant has withdrawn the Land Use Permit application for the proposed project. Please see the attached letter from the Applicant for more information.

Staff recommends the Board take the following actions:

- a) Accept the Applicant's withdrawal of the Land Use Permit (Case No. 18LUP-00000-00351);
- Acknowledge that upon withdrawal of the Land Use Permit, there is no action for the Board to take on the Permit and Appeal and drop the item from the Board of Supervisor's agenda;
- c) Determine that the above action is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15378(b)(5); and
- d) Waive the Notice of Exemption 6-day posting requirement for good cause pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section V.D.2.
