## SUBJECT: Professional Services Agreement with Kitchell/CEM, Inc.; All Districts

## Recommended Actions:

That the Board of Supervisors:

- a) Approve and authorize the Chair to execute Amendment No. 3 to the Contract with Kitchell/CEM, Inc. of San Luis Obispo, CA, which will provide for additional Project Management Services by increasing the maximum compensation limit from \$600,000.00 to \$1,025,000.00 (an increase of \$425,000.00); and
- b) Find that the recommended action is not a project under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to sections 15378(b)(4) and 15378(b)(5) of the CEQA Guidelines, because they consist of administrative and fiscal activities of government that will not result in direct or indirect physical changes in the environment.

#### Summary Text:

General Services is in need of amending the consulting, and project management services for various capital and facilities projects and programs including those approved by the Board of Supervisors and is engaging Kitchell to provide continuing on-site project management, engineering, architectural, and other services.

## Background:

Over the past year, the Board of Supervisors has approved over \$70 million of capital project work that will be managed by the General Services department. These projects include the main Santa Barbara County Jail renovation, the Lake Cachuma RV Park upgrades, the new Probation Building, the SB

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Courthouse Roof project, the Calle Real Master Plan, and the BeWell MHRC to name a few. To begin planning and design on these projects, on July 2, 2019 General Services sought and received Board of Supervisors approval to enter into a professional services agreement with Kitchell/CEM, Inc. for project management consultant services for a total contract amount not to exceed \$200,000. On November 5, 2019, Amendment No. 1 to this agreement was approved and broadened the services offered and increased the contract amount by \$75,000. After continuing to review the County's project management needs, Amendment No. 2 for additional services was requested and approved by the Board on February 25, 2020 which increased the contract amount by \$325,000, and extended the term of the agreement by 12 months to ensure there would be no delays in moving these and other projects forward. As we move into the next fiscal year and continue to review project management needs, General Services is requesting an additional \$425,000 be added to this contract to cover anticipated project management services needed beyond this fiscal year.

## Key Contract Risks:

The Professional Services Agreement identifies the scope the consultant must achieve in order to receive payment based hours of work performed and outcomes achieved.

## CEQA:

The proposed administrative actions do not constitute a project within the meaning of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to sections 15378(b)(4) and 15378(b)(5) of the CEQA Guidelines. An environmental analysis of any project resulting from this effort will be required, and any resulting environmental action will be brought to the Board for approval prior to construction.

## Fiscal and Facilities Impacts:

The contract amendment #3 is budgeted in the General Services' Capital Outlay Fund 0030, the General Fund Facilities Division budget, and other identified project funding sources.

Amendment #3 will increase the contract by \$425,000.00, for a total contract amount of \$1,025,000.00, ensuring no interruption in the management of the many capital and facilities maintenance projects and programs underway.
