Summary Text:

This item is on the agenda for the Board of Supervisors to review and execute an amendment to an agreement with the CDFA to extend the current agreement period to June 30, 2021, so as to receive reimbursement for the cost of all activities for a CDFA CalCannabis inspection program, up to \$140,000, for performing commercial cannabis cultivation compliance inspections of licensed cultivation sites in Santa Barbara County.

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Background:

In June 2017, the California Governor signed into law the Medicinal and Adult-Use Cannabis Regulation and Safety Act (MAUCRSA), which created one regulatory system for both medicinal and adult-use (recreational) cannabis. Under MAUCRSA, the CDFA was designated as the state agency responsible for issuing licenses to commercial cannabis cultivation in California. The Santa Barbara County Agricultural Commissioner in cooperation with the CDFA CalCannabis Division has been providing commercial cannabis cultivation inspections in support of the MAUCRSA for the CDFA CalCannabis program.
