- 2. Applicant is hereby authorized and directed to receive an ESG grant, in an amount not to exceed \$624,192 in accordance with all applicable rules and laws.
- 3. Applicant hereby agrees to use the ESG funds for eligible activities as approved by the Department and in accordance with all Program requirements, and other rules and laws, as well as in a manner consistent and in compliance with the Standard Agreement and other contracts between the Applicant and the Department.
- 4. The Community Services Director, or designee(s) in the event that sufficient evidence of designation is provided to the Department, is/are authorized to execute the Standard Agreement and any subsequent amendments or modifications thereto, aswell as any other documents which are related to the Program or the ESG grant awarded to Applicant, as the Department may deem appropriate.
