- A) Approve, ratify, and authorize the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to execute an agreement with the California Department of Food and Agriculture for support of services related to the Organic Inspection Program in the County of Santa Barbara for the period of July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021 in the amount of \$9060.00.
- B) Determine that the above action involves government funding mechanisms and/or fiscal activities and is not a project under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15378(b)(4).

## **Summary Text:**

This item is on the agenda for the Board of Supervisors to approve and authorize an agreement with the California Department of Food and Agriculture (CDFA) to receive reimbursement for the County's enforcement of the Organic Inspection Program. Through this agreement, the CDFA reimburses the Santa Barbara County Agricultural Commissioner's Office for the cost associated with the activities that ensure and maintain the integrity of the Organic Program through spot inspections and residue testing, as well as investigations of complaints. Also included in activities are market site inspections, production site inspections and producer and market investigations.

The Agricultural Commissioner's Office has operated an Organic program for many years. It is anticipated that funding and reimbursement for our Organic enforcement activities will continue.
