# Background

#### California Homestay Bill of 1999

- Regulates farms/ranches offering overnight visits
  - Exempt from more stringent requirements that apply to commercial restaurants
- Defines "Agricultural Homestay"
  - AKA "Restricted Food Service Transient Occupancy Establishments"
  - Used as a model for farmstays ordinances

# Background

- Gaviota Coast Plan
  - Farmstays allowed with a LUP/CDP
  - Agriculture-II zoned parcels
  - 40 acre minimum lot size
  - No new structures may be built for use as farmstays
  - Primary use of the land must be a working farm/ranch (farmstays are incidental)
  - 15 guest maximum food service for guests only

# Background & Purpose

- Agriculture Tiered Permitting (ATP) Project
  - Allow new, ag-related uses (e.g., farmstays, smallscale processing) in other areas besides the Gaviota Coast
- Process farmstays separate from ATP Project
  - Added as FY 19/20 LRP work program project
  - Allow farmstays throughout the unincorporated county

  - Uniform Rules
- Environmental Review
- Community and Stakeholder Outreach
- Coastal Commission Certification

# **Estimated Timeline**

### Fall/Winter 2020

- Prepare project description (text amendments to the LUDC, Article II, and Uniform Rules)
- Consultant selection
- Initiate public outreach
- □ Winter 2020 / Spring 2021
  - Prepare environmental document
  - Public review of environmental document

## **Estimated Timeline**

- Summer 2021
  - APAC hearings
  - Planning Commission and Board of Supervisors hearings
  - Initiate Coastal Commission certification process (approximately 15 months to complete)

- Clarify if the Board would like to pursue a different project that involves a broader scopeof-work.
  - Identify other LRP Work Program project(s) to delay; and/or
