Background

- Guidelines for the Implementation of the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970 As Amended ("County Guidelines")
 - Adopted 1988; last revised in 2010
 - State CEQA Guidelines (§15022): directs each public agency to adopt objectives, criteria, and specific procedures consistent with CEQA and the State CEQA Guidelines

Background

- Environmental Thresholds and Guidelines Manual ("ETM")
 - Adopted 1988; last revised 2018
 - State CEQA Guidelines [§15064.7(b)]: encourages each public agency to adopt thresholds of significance

County CEQA Guidelines Amendments

- Align administrative practices with revised
 State CEQA Guidelines
 - 2019 State Office of Planning and Research amendments to the State CEQA Guidelines
- Revise hearing procedures for adopting revisions to the ETM
- Clarify existing County procedures
- Attachment 2, Exhibit 1

Environmental Thresholds Manual Amendments

- Delete "Criteria for Amendment" from the ETM
- Revise quality of life guidelines
 - Clarify how to consider quality of life:
 - Identify physical impacts resulting from changes to quality of life
 - Determine whether a physical change is a significant effect
 - Nexus between the change to quality of life and physical impact is key

ETM Amendments

- Revise quality of life guidelines (continued)
 - Quality of life (e.g., social and economic) impacts may still be considerations of Comprehensive Plan policies and regulations
 - Example: Traffic congestion (level of service)
- Discontinue Class I-IV method of categorizing environmental impacts

ETM Amendments

- Revise certain noise thresholds
 - Remove subjectivity and provide quantitative thresholds for determining significant noise effect:

Existing Ambient Noise Environment	Significant effect if the project, or project + cumulative, noise levels increase to:
Indoor	
≤ 45 dB(A)	> 45 dB(A)
> 45 dB(A)	Ambient + 3 dB(A)
Outdoor	
≤ 65 dB(A)	> 65 dB(A)
> 65 dB(A)	Ambient + 3 dB(A)

County Planning Commission

 - Approve the proposed amendments, with one minor change.
