The Department of Social Services (DSS) will be allocated an additional \$75,200 from the State of California, Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) to provide the Transitional Housing Program in Santa Barbara County.

# **Background:**

On June 27, 2019, Governor Newsom signed Senate Bill (SB) 80, the budget trailer bill that provides \$8 million annually to reduce homelessness among California's former foster youth. The purpose of the funding through SB 80 requires the newly available funding to be used to help young adults between the ages of 18 years and up to 24 years old secure and maintain housing. SB 80 requires that priority for the funding be given to young adults formerly in the state's foster care or probation systems. The DSS will be allocated funds to assist in those efforts in Santa Barbara County.

Use of funds may include, but are not limited to:

- 1. Identify and assist housing services for this population;
- 2. Assist this population to secure and maintain housing with priority given to the state's foster care or probation system;
- 3. Improve coordination of services and linkages to community resources within the child welfare system and the Homeless Continuum of Care; and
- 4. Provide engagement in outreach and targeting to serve those with the most severe needs.

On July 27, 2020, HCD was allocated a second round of funding for an additional \$8 million, of which, DSS will be allocated \$75,200.

As a requirement to apply for and accept the allocation, applicants must submit a signed Resolution to HCD.
