## **Background and Jurisdiction**

- COVID-19 Ordinance Amendments passed by the Board of Supervisors on June 16, 2020
  - Regulations regarding the temporary suspension of compliance with certain requirements of approved permits, legal non-conforming uses, and a hardship time extension in order to protect public health and limit the spread of COVID-19
  - Expire on December 16, 2020, or when the proclaimed Santa Barbara County Local Emergency from COVID-19 is terminated, whichever is earlier

### **Proposed Ordinance Amendments**

- Extend the expiration of these temporary allowances to:
  - The earlier of when the Board of Supervisors declares the proclaimed Santa Barbara County Local Emergency from the COVID-19 virus is terminated, or when the COVID-19 provisions are terminated by ordinance amendment

- Will not result in inconsistencies with adopted policies and development standards
- Consistent with LUDC, MLUDC and Article II as amendments only extend the expiration date of the COVID-19 ordinance amendments
