

## Santa Barbara County COVID-19 By The Numbers


#### **CUMULATIVE CASE STATUS REPORTED AS OF TODAY**


#### 7-DAY ROLLING SUM OF NEW CASES BY AREA

## **COVID in California: Daily Confirmed New Cases**





# Blueprint for a Safer Economy

# **Blueprint Framework**

**County risk level** 

	100K with 7-day lag, adjusted for number of tests performed	that are positive
WIDESPREAD  Many non-essential indoor business operations are closed	More than 7 Daily new cases (per 100k)	More than 8% Positive tests
SUBSTANTIAL  Some non-essential indoor business operations are closed	<b>4-7</b> Daily new cases (per 100k)	5 – 8% and 5.3 – 8% health equity metric Positive tests
MODERATE  Some indoor business operations are open with modifications	1 - 3.9  Daily new cases (per 100k)	2 – 4.9% and 2.2 – 5.2% health equity metric
MINIMAL  Most indoor business operations are open with modifications	Less than 1 Daily new cases (per 100k)	Less than 2% and Less than 2.2% health equity metric

7-day average of all COVID-19 tests performed



\*Small counties (those with a population less than 106,000) may be subject to alternate case assessment measures for purposes of tier assignment.



#### Santa Barbara County 7-day Average Adjusted\* Case Rate per 100,000 Community Residents


