- Exempt: Board-adopted resolution 9/15/2020
- Project already includes VMT reduction measures







## **REQUESTED CONDITION MODIFICATIONS**

Project design evolved significantly as a result of community input

Modifications retain conditions and community input while meeting current design standards for safety and operations

### **REQUESTED CONDITION MODIFICATIONS**

26 Conditions, only requesting minor modifications to five:

#19: Modifies language to allow for safety and design elements supported at community meetings, by the Design Working Group, and approved by Montecito Board of Architectural Review, to be incorporated into project. Also references existing views vs. photo representations

#21: Modifies condition to match existing conditions and constraints - there is no pole immediately east of the project and undergrounding could be determined infeasible on the west

#22: Clarifies that wood signs will be used where not in conflict with Federal, State, and Local sign requirements for safety

#23: Clarifies condition to match how these agreements are set up throughout the rest of the County and the State using Freeway Maintenance Agreements

#25: Clarifies the condition to allow plants chosen by the Design Working Group and Montecito Board of Architectural Review, and Landscape Designer, provided Montecito Fire District approves
