That the Board of Supervisors:

- a) Approve the plans and specifications on file in the Public Works Department office for construction of Hot Springs Road Shoulder Improvements; County Project No. 820764; First Supervisorial District;
- b) Award the attached construction contract, Hot Springs Road Shoulder Improvements; County Project No. 820764 in the amount of \$260,320.00 to the lowest responsible bidder, CalPortland Construction (a local Vendor), PO Box 1280, Santa Maria, CA 93456, subject to the provision of documents and certifications, as set forth in the specifications applicable to the project, as required under California Law;
- c) Approve and authorize the Director of Public Works or designee, to approve change orders for a contingency amount up to \$27,016.00 and supplemental items of \$30,000.00, for the construction of County Project 820764 for a total not to exceed authorization of \$317,336.00;
- d) Approve and authorize the Chair to execute the attached construction contract, which has been reviewed and approved by County Counsel, Auditor-Controller and Risk Manager, or their authorized representatives; and
- e) Find this project is exempt from the provisions of California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to 14 CCR 15301(c) (as the proposed project(s) consists of the operation, repair, maintenance, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of use beyond that previously existing, including but

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not limited to existing highways and streets, sidewalks, gutters, bicycle and pedestrian trails, and similar facilities), and approve the filing of the attached Notice of Exemption on that basis.

Summary Text:

This item is on the agenda to award a construction contract for shoulder improvements on Hot Springs Road from the City of Santa Barbara to Middle Road. On November 10, 2020, one (1) bid was opened for Hot Springs Road Shoulder Improvements; County Project No. 820764 ("Project"). CalPortland Construction submitted the lowest responsive and responsible bid in the amount of \$260,320.00 which is 10.2% above the Engineer's Estimate.

This project was bid in accordance with the Public Contract Code, which requires the award go to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder. The Department analyzed the bids and determined the low bid is responsive and responsible. Although it is 10.2% above the Engineer's Estimate, the bid is commensurate with the current competitive bidding climate, which is also reflected in the fact that only one bidder submitted for this project. The Department recommends awarding this contract to CalPortland Construction.

Background:

This project will reconstruct the shoulder of Hot Springs Road from the City Limits to Middle Road in conformance with the Montecito Community Plan by creating an informal pathway on the south shoulder. The pavement on Hot Springs Road was rehabilitated to repair damage from trucking and other construction traffic during 1/9 Debris Flow response and subsequent recovery. As part of this project the lanes were shifted slightly northwest to create additional space on the southeast side. This project will move the curb and create the subgrade for an informal walking path.

This path will create a vital pedestrian link in the trail network throughout Montecito and create an area for pedestrians to avoid walking in the bike lane.
