WHEREAS, California Vehicle Code Sections 22507, and 22507.5 and the Code of Santa Barbara County, California, Section 23-11, authorize the Board of Supervisors of the County, to establish parking regulations on portions of roads and highways under its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of public safety that certain portions of County highways in Santa Barbara County be designated as no commercial vehicle parking zones, or no stopping, standing, or parking zones, in accordance with said Sections;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED, that the following locations in Santa Barbara County and under the jurisdiction of the Board of Supervisors of said County are hereby designated as commercial vehicle parking zone, or no stopping, standing, or parking zones, and that the Director of Public Works of the County of Santa Barbara is hereby authorized and directed to install and maintain appropriate pavement markings and signs at the following locations:

## No Commercial Vehicle Parking Zone

- On both sides of Sinaloa Drive from San Ysidro Road to Santa Rosa Lane.
- On both sides of Malaga Drive from Sinaloa Drive to the northern terminus.
- On both sides of Avila Way from Sinaloa Drive to the northern terminus.

## No Stopping, Standing or Parking Zone

- On the west side of Puente Drive from a point 364' north of Vintage Ranch Lane (north) to the north roadway edge of More Mesa Drive.
- On both sides of Camino Del Remedio from the centerline of Cathedral Oaks Road to a point 516' south of the centerline of Cathedral Oaks Road.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the Santa Barbara County Director of Public Works or designee is hereby authorized and directed to install appropriate markings and/or signs at said locations as time and resources permit.
