1. Authorize and approve the Chair to execute a Letter of Support for Congressional funding for the California Space Center.

Summary Text:

Recently the County of Santa Barbara received a request from Janice Dunn, Deputy Director of the California Space Authority, representing the California Space Center, requesting the Board of Supervisors' support of a \$2 million federal funding request via the Department of Defense National Defense Education Program. This item is on the Board of Supervisors agenda for review of stated request

Background:

The California Space Center is proposed at the edge of the Vandenberg Air Force Base. With 12 to 15 Vandenberg launches taking place each year, it is anticipated that the center will attract thousands of visitors to the area. The center is slated to include a visitors complex, interpretive center, theater, amphitheater, youth education facilities, conference center and launch viewing facilities (Attachment B).

In addition the California Space Center is projected to create 2,994 jobs in Santa Barbara County and promote and inspire the study of science, technology, engineering and math throughout the state.

The California Space Center will be developed in three phases via government, public and private sources. Phase 1: \$62 million 2 years, Phase II: \$90.8 million 5 years, Phase III: \$67.7 million 2 years.
