Summary Text:

This item is on the agenda for consideration of naming the Cuyama Pool in honor of Fifth District Supervisor Joseph Centeno. Supervisor Centeno has worked tirelessly since his election to the Santa Barbara County Board of Supervisors to ensure that the residents of Cuyama received much needed programs, services and facilities. The construction of the Cuyama Pool, support facilities and amenities represents a significant milestone in his ongoing efforts. Supervisor Centeno's unwavering support and dedication made the Cuyama Pool a reality for the 800 residents of the Cuyama Valley.

Background:

Upon taking office in 2003, Supervisor Centeno worked to ensure that the 800 residents of the Cuyama Valley once again had a swimming pool, a critical resource given the extreme summer weather in the Cuyama Valley, available to them. His concern and dedication to ensuring children and adults of the area have appropriate services, programs, and facilities directly resulted in the initiation and ultimate completion of the project.
