Farming LLC – Cannabis Cultivation Buellton (Gwen Beyeler, (805) 934-6269, Planner) Jurisdiction: Cannabis Request of Lindsay Cokeley, agent for Blue Ribbon Farms, to consider Case No. 20BAR-00000-00057 for Conceptual Review of 52 refrigerated agricultural storage containers that are 320 square feet and new landscaping which would provide screening within 5 years. The following structures currently exist on the parcel: 3 agriculture buildings, 2 agricultural employee dwellings and 1 greenhouse. The proposed project will not require grading. The property is a 68.19 acre parcel zoned AG-II and shown as Assessor's Parcel Number 083-180-007 located at 8701 Santa Rosa Road in the Buellton area, Third

- 1. Project is unsupportable at this time as it is currently presented
- 2. Structures not compatible, designed, or placed, in a manner that is acceptable. If the Board is unable to effect a process of review wherein those structures can be upgraded, then the Board is at an impasse. Board would like to see the project improve on the existing conditions and on what is proposed. To that end, the board would like to see landscape architect, architect, and other members of the design team given free rein to create a landscape master plan for the site.
- 3. The board would like planning staff to provide the criteria under which these structures are being reviewed; are these temporary or permanent structures?
- 4. Suggest that the guard shack be made a permanent structure
- 5. Structures should be detailed in an architectural manner consistent with the development in the Valley
- 6. Landscape screening is not a pancea for poor architecture nor is it acceptable; the problem of poor architecture must be addressed.
- 7. Provide a landscape design consistent with the surrounded developed and undeveloped agrarian setting
- 8. The spacing of plantings is inadequate; size of plant materials is inadequate
- 9. The proposed narrow strips of landscaping are inadequate; a monoculture is not the way to go; more trees are needed, including in and around the buildings.
- 10. Restore landscaping wherever possible.

Applicant received conceptual review only, applicant may come back for further conceptual review. Member Brady abstained.

1. CBAR continues to find it very difficult to review this type of "structure" (e.g. containers, hoop houses) because the ability to modify the design is extremely limited. CBAR continues to question why design review is requested or required for these types of structures. Within the scope of our constrained purview, here are our comments:

2. Landscaping

- a. Landscaping has come a long way; response is broad and well thought out
- b. Concerned that the planned 3-year placement of structures could be extended
- c. More mature plantings recommended along western property line
- d. Suggest replacement of Cupressus leilandii
- e. Ironwood can be very microclimate sensitive
- f. Applicant can't rely upon landscaping on neighboring property; consider adding landscaping along the western property line similar to what is shown on the eastern property line; the trees along the eastern property line are critical for screening
- g. Approach to planting along Santa Rosa Rd. is nicely nuanced to create a more organic and mixed pattern that is evocative of a more natural planting
- h. Planters with green screen should be painted all one color
- i. The addition of trees along buildings D and M is a nice touch
- j. Planters on the northern end helps to bookend the containers
- k. Provide specifications for green screen material

3. Lighting

- a. Appreciate that you are showing what is in keeping with Sheriffs' department requirements
- b. Would like more information about the pole light by the guard house; identify materials

4. Structures

- a. The proposed changes to the guardhouse are very nice. Because it has been improved, it could be a more prominent structure
- b. Containers are utilitarian and therefore it is difficult to make architectural comments
- c. Containers need to be homogenous as far as color; a paint color is needed

The project also includes new landscaping which would provide screening in five years. The following structures currently exist on the parcel: 3 agriculture buildings, 2 agricultural employee dwellings and 1 greenhouse. The proposed project will not require grading. The property is a 68.19 acre parcel zoned AG-II and shown as Assessor's Parcel Number 083-180-007 located at 8701 Santa Rosa Road in the Buellton area, Third Supervisorial District. (Continued from 6-12-20 & 07-17-20)

- 1. CBAR continues to find it very difficult to review this type of "structure" (e.g. containers, hoop houses) because the ability to modify the design is extremely limited. CBAR continues to question why design review is requested or required for these types of structures. Within the scope of our constrained purview, and the fact that the storage structures will be removed, the CBAR has come as far as possible and offers the following comments:
- 2. Landscaping has come a long way and has been incorporated nicely, especially given the constraints that are present
- 3. Prefer "great barrrington green" (preffered) or "alligator alley" color
- 4. Green screen material is acceptable
- 5. CBAR doesn't have a preference with regard to where the panel is mounted in the green screen planters; final location is at the discretion of the landscape architect
- 6. The applicant has confirmed that the whole container will be painted and that there will be no text or trim
- 7. Storage structures are not architecture
- 8. Lower portion of the planters should be allowed to weather such that they "grey out" and not have any sealant/stain applied
- 9. If it takes 1.5 years for landscaping to grow in on a project, when the proposed containers will be removed in 3 years, the landscape screening will be of limited benefit
- 10. Land use permit should reflect the proposed parking location as shown on the plans

Conceptual review received, applicant may return for Preliminary Approval.
