WHEREAS, pursuant to Government Code Section 30061, the Juvenile Justice Crime Prevention Act requires a local Juvenile Justice Coordinating Council (JJCC) with membership as described in Welfare and Institutions Code Section 749.22;

WHEREAS, Welfare and Institutions Code section 1995 requires the creation of a Juvenile Justice Realignment Subcommittee (JJRS) of the JJCC with membership as described in section 1995(b);

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the following are designated as members of the Santa Barbara JJCC and the JJRS:

JJCC Permanent Members:

- · Chief Probation Officer, as Chair
- District Attorney
- · Sheriff-Coroner
- Public Defender
- Board of Supervisors, two (2) members as designated by the Board
- · Department of Social Services
- Superior Court Executive Officer
- · Juvenile Justice Delinquency Prevention Commission (JJDPC) Chair
- County Education Office
- · Department of Behavioral Wellness
- · County Executive Office

JJCC two-year term members selected from the following agencies:

- A representative from a maximum of two separate community-based drug and alcohol programs as selected by a coalition of said providers,
- A representative from a maximum of three city police departments as selected by the County Law Enforcement Chiefs,
- A representative from three separate local school districts as selected by a coalition of said districts.
- A representative from a maximum of two separate non-profit community-based agencies serving
 juveniles, to be selected through an application process and appointed by the permanent
 members of the Council.
- A researcher with knowledge and/or experience of the Juvenile Justice System, to be selected through an application process and appointed by the permanent members of the Council, and
- A community member with a preference for formerly justice-involved youth, to be selected through an application process and appointed by the permanent members of the Council.

JJRS members:

- · Chief Probation Officers, as Chair
- · The representative from the District Attorney's Office
- . The representative from the Public Defender's Office
- · The representative from the Department of Social Services
- The representative from the Department of Behavioral Wellness
- The representative from the County Office of Education or a School District
- The Court Executive Officer
- No fewer than three community members, selected from among the existing JJCC communitybased youth service organizations representatives.

IT IS FURTHER UNDERSTOOD that permanent members of the JJCC may designate, in writing to the JJCC Chairperson, an alternate member to represent the member at a Council meeting in the event the Council member is unable to attend.
