Recommended Actions:

That the Board of Supervisors:

- A. Approve and authorize the Chair to adopt Resolutions (4) establishing: a loading zone on Pardall Road; "No Parking" on Pardall Road; a 15-minute parking zone on Embarcadero Del Norte; and a one-hour parking zone on Madrid Road, in the Isla Vista area, Third Supervisorial District.
- B. Approve and authorize the Chair to adopt Resolutions (2) rescinding: Resolution 71-586 to remove no parking on a portion of Pardall Road; and a portion of Resolution 84-551 to remove a 15-minute parking zone on Trigo Road, in the Isla Vista area, Third Supervisorial District.
- C. Approve the filing of a Notice of Exemption pursuant to California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines Section 15301 (c), pertaining to maintenance and operation of existing facilities, for this project.

Summary Text:

The Public Works Transportation Division and the Isla Vista Foot Patrol met in May 2010, to address parking issues in the Isla Vista area. Several locations were identified as needing improvements in order to function more safely and efficiently. Public Works is recommending that the Board adopt the attached Resolutions to change existing parking restrictions at the locations identified. In addition to the locations in the attached Resolutions, several other locations were identified as needing refreshed red curb paint or additional signage. Public Works is working with the Isla Vista Foot Patrol to address these needs.

The Public Works Department has prepared the attached Resolutions establishing or rescinding parking restrictions at the following location:

ADOPT

Loading Parking Zone

• On the south side of Pardall Road, between a point 237 feet east of the centerline of Embarcadero Del Norte, and a point 317 feet east of the centerline of Embarcadero Del Norte. This area is currently a "No Parking" zone established by Resolution 71-586.

<u>No Parking</u>

On the south side of Pardall Road, between the centerline of Embarcadero Del Norte, and a
point 237 feet east of the centerline of Embarcadero Del Norte, and on the south side of Pardall
Road, between a point 317 feet east of the centerline of Embarcadero Del Norte, and the easterly
terminus of Pardall Road. This does not eliminate any existing parking zones and is currently
part of a "No Parking" zone established by Resolution 71-586. The limits of the "No Parking"
are being reduced to accommodate the requested "Loading Zone".

15-Minute Parking Zone

• On the west side of Embarcadero Del Norte, between a point 67 feet south of the centerline of Pardall Road, and a point 117 feet south of the centerline of Pardall Road.

One-Hour Parking Zone

• On the south side of Madrid Road between a point 58 feet East of the centerline of Embarcadero Del Norte and a point 144 feet East of the centerline of Embarcadero Del Norte.

RESCIND

No Parking Zone

• Rescind all of Resolution No. 71-586 for "No Parking" *on the south side of Pardall Road from west boundary of the University of California Campus and the east boundary of Embarcadero Del Norte.* This Resolution is being replaced with a new Resolution to establish a "Loading Zone" and a "No Parking Zone" in this area.

• Portion of Resolution No. 84-551 (f) on the south side of Trigo Road between the centerline of Embarcadero Del Mar and a point 81 feet west of the centerline of Embarcadero Del Mar.

Background:

Parking restrictions are either established or rescinded based on safety, necessity, and the affect on the community as a whole. The Public Works Department weighs all of these factors, and presents any recommended changes to the Board of Supervisors for approval. These parking restrictions may include no parking, time limited parking, loading zones, vehicle height restricted parking, angle parking, handicapped parking, or any combination of these restrictions.
