

NOTICE OF EXEMPTION

TO: Santa Barbara County Clerk of the Board of Supervisors

Based on a preliminary review of the project the following activity is determined to be exempt from further environmental review requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) of 1970 (Pub. Res. Code Section 21000 et seq.), as defined in the State CEQA Guidelines and County Revised CEQA Guidelines.

LOCATION : ADOPT Loading Parking Zone: On the south side of Pardall Road between a point 237 feet east of the centerline of Embarcadero Del Norte and a point 317 feet east of the centerline of Embarcadero Del Norte. No Parking: On the south side of Pardall Road between the centerline of Embarcadero Del Norte and a point 237 feet east of the centerline of Embarcadero Del Norte, and on the south side of Pardall Road between a point 317 feet east of the centerline of Embarcadero Del Norte and the easterly terminus of Pardall Road. 15 Minute Parking Zone: On the west side of Embarcadero Del Norte between a point 67 feet south of the centerline of Pardall Road and a point 117 feet south of the centerline of Pardall Road. One Hour Parking Zone: On the south side of Madrid Road between a point 58 feet east of the centerline of Embarcadero Del Norte and a point 144 feet east of the centerline of Embarcadero Del Norte.

LOCATION : RESCIND 15 Minute Parking Zone: Portion of Resolution No. 84-551 (f) on the south side of Trigo Road between the centerline of Embarcadero Del Mar and a point 81 feet west of the centerline of Embarcadero Del Mar. No Parking Zone: Rescind all of Resolution No. 71-586 for no parking on the south side of Pardall Road from west boundary of the University of California Campus and the east boundary of Embarcadero Del Norte.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:


Adopt resolutions establishing a loading zone on Pardall Road, No Parking on Pardall Road, 15 minute parking zone on Embarcadero Del Norte, one hour parking zone on Madrid Road, and rescind a portion of Resolution 84-551 to remove a 15 minute parking zone on Trigo, and rescind resolution 71-586 to remove no parking on a portion of Pardall Road in the Isla Vista area; 3rd Supervisorial District.

Cite specific CEQA Guideline Section 15301 (c) Existing Facilities – "...consists of the operation, repair, maintenance, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of use beyond that previously existing, including but not limited to:...(c) Existing highways and streets, sidewalks, gutters, bicycle and pedestrian trails, and similar facilities (this includes road grading for the purpose of public safety), except where the activity will involve removal of a scenic resource including a stand of trees, a rock outcropping, or an historic building.

Reasons to support exemption findings: The project is the adoption of a Resolution to adopt an Ordinance which consists of the operation County infrastructure, therefore this project is contemplated by the CEQA exemption under section 15301. Further, there are no unusual circumstances which would create a possibility that there would be a significant effect. The project is an ordinance amendment which allows for a public safety activity designed to maintain a safe traveling condition of the highway facility as it was constructed.
