Based on a preliminary review of the project the following activity is determined to be exempt from further environmental review requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) of 1970 (Pub. Res. Code Section 21000 et seq.), as defined in the State CEQA Guidelines and County Revised CEQA Guidelines.

LOCATION: A half mile from Cathedral Oaks Drive on San Marcos Pass road.

PROJECT TITLE San Marcos Road Bridge (51C-002) Seismic Repair


PROJECT DESCRIPTION. The project involves the seismic retrofit of Bridge #51C-002 over Maria Ygnacia Creek in Santa Barbara County. The bridge is .5 miles from Cathedral Oaks Drive on San Marcos Pass road. The steps involved are that the existing hinge of the bridge will be locked up with splice plates and replacement deck, new steel elements will be added to the existing steel angle brace for increased capacity; anchor bolts will be added to the existing column base connection; the "leg" will be welded to the face of the existing column; and 5/8-inch-thick flange spacer plates will be added. The project is within the County road right of way.

Cite specific CEQA Guideline Section 15301 (c) Existing Facilities – "...consists of the operation, repair, maintenance, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of use beyond that previously existing, including but not limited to...(c) Existing highways and streets, sidewalks, gutters, bicycle and pedestrian trails, and similar facilities (this includes road grading for the purpose of public safety), except where the activity will involve removal of a scenic resource including a stand of trees, a rock outcropping, or an historic building.

Reasons to support exemption findings: The project is seismic repair of an existing County maintained bridge and therefore is contemplated by the CEQA exemption under section 15301. The project has been determined to be exempt from Santa Barbara County P&D permit requirements and a NEPA Categorical Exclusion has been issued under Section 6004. Further, there are no unusual circumstances which would create a possibility that there would be a significant effect. The project is a seismic retrofit of an existing bridge to maintain a safe traveling condition of the highway facility as it was constructed.
