In June 2017, the California Governor signed into law the Medicinal and Adult-Use Cannabis Regulation and Safety Act (MAUCRSA), which created one regulatory system for both medicinal and adult-use (recreational) cannabis. Under MAUCRSA, the CDFA was designated as the state agency responsible for issuing licenses to commercial cannabis cultivation in California. The Santa Barbara County Agricultural Commissioner in cooperation with the CDFA CalCannabis Division may provide commercial cannabis cultivation inspections in support of the MAUCRSA for the CDFA CalCannabis program.
