A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLETA, CALIFORNIA, CALLING AND GIVING NOTICE OF THE HOLDING OF A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE CITY ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 2, 2010, FOR THE ELECTION OF CERTAIN OFFICERS AS REQUIRED BY THE PROVISIONS OF THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA RELATING TO GENERAL LAW CITIES.

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the laws relating to general law cities in the State of California, a General Municipal Election shall be held on November 2, 2010, for the election of Municipal Officers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLETA AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1.

That pursuant to the requirements of the laws of the State of California relating to General Law Cities, there is called and ordered to be held in the City of Goleta, California, on Tuesday, November 2, 2010, a General Municipal Election for the purpose of electing three Members of the City Council for the full term of four years.

SECTION 2.

That the ballots to be used at the election shall be in form and content as required by law.

SECTION 3.

The City Clerk is authorized, instructed and directed to procure and furnish any and all official ballots, notices, printed matter and all supplies, equipment and paraphernalia that may be necessary in order to properly and lawfully conduct the election.

SECTION 4.

That the polls for the election shall be open at seven o'clock a.m. of the day of the election and shall remain open continuously from that time until eight o'clock p.m. of the same day when the polls shall be closed, except as provided in Section 14401 of the Elections Code of the State of California.

SECTION 5.

That in all particulars not recited in this resolution, the election shall be held and conducted as provided by law for holding municipal elections.

SECTION 6.

That notice of the time and place of holding the election is given and the City Clerk is authorized, instructed and directed to give further or additional notice of the election, in time, form and manner as required by law.

SECTION 7.

That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of original Resolutions.

RESOLUTION NO. 10-30

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLETA, CALIFORNIA, REQUESTING THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF SANTA BARBARA TO CONSOLIDATE A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 2, 2010 WITH THE STATEWIDE GENERAL ELECTION

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Goleta called a General Municipal Election to be held on November 2, 2010, for the purpose of the election of three members of the City Council for four-year full terms; and

WHEREAS, there is a Statewide General Election scheduled for November 2, 2010; and

WHEREAS, California Elections Code section 10403 authorizes General Municipal Elections to be consolidated with a Statewide General Election, and

WHEREAS, it is desirable for convenience and cost savings efficiency that the General Municipal Election be consolidated with the Statewide General Election to be held on the same date and that within the City the precincts, polling places and election officers of the two elections be the same, and that the County Election Division of the County of Santa Barbara canvass the returns of the General Municipal Election and that the election be held in all respects as if there were only one election.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLETA DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1.

That pursuant to the requirements of Section 10403 of the Elections Code, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara is hereby requested to consent and agree to the consolidation of a General Municipal Election with the Statewide General Election on Tuesday, November 2, 2010, for the purpose of the election of three Members of the City Council for four-year full terms.

SECTION 2.

That the County Election Division is authorized to canvass the returns of the General Municipal Election. The election shall be held in all respects as if there were only one election, and only one form of ballot shall be used.

SECTION 3.

That the Board of Supervisors is requested to issue instructions to the County Election Division to take any and all steps necessary for the holding of the consolidated election.

SECTION 4.

That the City of Goleta recognizes that additional costs will be incurred by the County by reason of this consolidation and agrees to reimburse the County for such costs.

SECTION 5.

That the City Clerk is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this resolution with the Board of Supervisors and the County Election Division of the County of Santa Barbara.

SECTION 6.

That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.
