## FY 2021 Action Plan

- Action Plan was approved by the Board on April 20, 2021 and was submitted to HUD
- Action Plan contained the Board-approved Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding awards
- A few changes have transpired requiring an Action Plan amendment and other Board Action



## Reallocation of CDBG Public Services Funds

- \$17,911 to reallocate in CDBG funds
  - 1. \$15,000 previously awarded to CommUnify for its Senior Nutrition Program, which was discontinued on July 1
  - 2. \$2,911 in additional funds made available by HUD resulting from a recalculation of FY 2021 CDBG allocations
- Human Services Commission's Allocation Committee met on July 1, 2021 and made the following funding recommendations for Board consideration



## Reallocation of CDBG Public Services Funds

- 1. Total: \$17,911 CDBG
- \$4,251 in additional funding for Meals on Wheels Santa Maria Valley (total funding \$20,000)
- 3. \$13,660 for Santa Ynez Valley Senior Citizens Foundation's Meals on Wheels Program (not previously included in 2021 funding awards)



#### Reallocation of HSC General Fund Awards

**Local Funds not part of HUD-required Action Plan Amendment** 

- \$30,000 from the general fund for Human Services programs was awarded by the Board to CommUnify for its Senior Nutrition Program
  - Program discontinued July 1

#### and

- \$30,000 was awarded to the Unitarian Society to operate Freedom Warming Centers
  - Demand has reached Unitarian Society's capacity and Good Samaritan Shelter agreed to take over the operation of the program



## Reallocation of HSC General Fund Awards

## **HSC** Recommends that:

 \$30,000 previously awarded to CommUnify be reallocated to the Central Coast Commission for Senior Citizens, which will continue a senior meal program

and

 \$30,000 previously awarded to the Unitarian Society for the Freedom Warming Centers be reallocated to Good Samaritan Shelter



## Action Plan Amendment/Public Comment Period

Relating to the CDBG funds, HUD requires:

- 1.Substantial Amendment to the FY 2021
  Action Plan to reallocate funds not previously included in the FY 2021-22 Action Plan
- 2. Public Comment Period
  - > 30-day public comment period:

- Approve Action Plan Amendment and execute CDBG agreements to:
  - 1. Meals on Wheels Santa Maria Valley \$20,000 and
  - 2. Santa Ynez Valley People Helping People \$13,660
- Approve HSC general funds, and execute agreements to:
  - 1. Central Coast Commission for Senior Citizens \$30,000 and
  - 2. Good Samaritan Shelter \$30,000
- Determine that the recommended actions are not acceptance and approval of a project subject to environmental review under CEQA (CEQA Guidelines Section 15378(b)(4))
