PUBLIC CONVENIENCE OR NECESSITY

You have filed an application to sell alcoholic beverages in a Census Tract which contains more licenses per population than the County average.

The Department cannot issue more licenses in this Census Tract unless a letter is submitted to the Department. If you have applied for a type 41 or type 47 license, you will need to prepare the letter with a clear explanation of your proposed type business, and reasons why your proposed premises will satisfy public convenience or necessity. If you have applied for a type 20, 21, 40, 42, 48 or 60 license the letter will have to be provided by the City or County officials specified by the law.

If public convenience and necessity can be established, the Department may impose conditions on the license to insure that the business will be operated in an acceptable manner as contained in your statement.

If you fail to establish public convenience or necessity, the Department will have no choice but to recommend denial of your application.

If you have questions concerning this requirement, you should contact the Investigator assigned to your application at Ph# (805) 543-7183.

Your proposed premise is located in an area where there is an over concentration of alcoholic beverage licenses. Therefore, pursuant to the above mentioned section, grounds exist for the <u>denial</u> of your application for an alcoholic beverage license.

The Department will require a letter stating how Public Convenience or Necessity would be served by issuance of the applied for license. The letter should address the following:

- 1. How your premises will provide products and/or services different and unique to area, that existing businesses in the area do not provide.
- 2. How issuance of the license and/or premises operation <u>WOULD NOT</u> contribute to or aggravate police problems.

Included in this could be:

- a) Your knowledge of the area, previous experience in business or the previous operation of a licensed premise.
- b) Precautions/Guidelines you can follow to ensure that your premises/business will be operated properly.
- c) If you have had previous experience in a business with an alcoholic beverage license, what measures you will take to learn and enforce ABC rules.
- 3. Requests by customers for the service/sales of alcoholic beverages and the need to keep up with competitors DOES NOT JUSTIFY CONVENIENCE OR NECESSITY.
