- 1. The Board of Supervisors approves the filing an application for grant funds from the Sustainable Communities Planning Grant and Incentive Program under the Safe Drinking Water, Water Quality and Supply, Flood Control River and Coastal Protection Bond Act of 2006 (Proposition 84) in order to foster the sustainability of Santa Barbara County.
- 2. The Board of Supervisors certifies that Planning and Development understands the assurances and certifications stating that the information contained in the plan application is complete and accurate.
- 3. The Board of Supervisors certifies that the Proposal complies with any applicable laws and regulations and all subsequent implementing actions will comply with any applicable laws and regulations.
- 4. The Board of Supervisors appoints the Director of Planning and Development, or designee, as agent to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents including, but not limited to applications, agreements, payment requests and so on, which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned project.
