Recommended Actions:

That the Board of Supervisors:

- A. Rescind a Resolution that established a disabled persons parking zone on Union Avenue in the Orcutt area, Fourth Supervisorial District; and
- B. Approve the filing of a Notice of Exemption, pursuant to California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines Section 15301 (c), pertaining to maintenance and operation of existing facilities for this project.

Summary Text:

There is a disabled persons parking stall in front of a townhouse on the north side of Union Avenue, between Pacific Street and Gray Street. Public Works received a request from the townhouse owner to remove the disabled persons parking stall because the disabled resident who used it had moved away. Based on our investigation, we determined that the disabled persons parking stall is not utilized and should be removed. Public Works has prepared the attached Resolution to remove the disabled parking zone at the following location:

Rescind Disabled Persons Parking Zone

On the north side of Union Avenue from a point 112 feet west of the centerline of Gray Street to a point 127 feet west of the centerline of Gray Street.

Background:

Parking restrictions are either established or rescinded based on safety, necessity, and community use as a whole. The Department weighs all of these factors and presents any recommended changes to the

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Board of Supervisors for approval. These parking restrictions may include no parking, time limited parking, loading zones, vehicle height restricted parking, angle parking, disabled persons parking, or any combination of these restrictions.

Public Works established the Union Avenue disabled persons parking stall on April 22, 2008, based on a request from a disabled resident that could not safely access their townhouse. That resident has since moved away, and the stall is no longer necessary.
