

PG&E Initial Evaluation

(Summary of Shoreline Fault, Cluff and Abrahamson, 10 June 2009)

Magnitude

- Based on the size of the fault
 - 24 km length (extended to the intersection with Hosgri)
 - 12 km depth
- M = 6.5
- Distance
 - 1 km from DCPP (assumed)



Pertinent Dates

 14 November 2008. PG&E informed the NRC of previously unknown fault located offshore of the DCPP.

• "Early 2009" (NRC): Determines "adequate seismic margin".



Pertinent Dates (Cont.)

 24 November 2009. PG&E announces application for 20-year extension to current licenses (2024 (Unit 1) 2025 (Unit 2)).

 25 May 2012 (Projected). NRC Relicensing Decision (if hearing required).



Board Options to Address Issue

- 1. Defer to NRC, CPUC and PG&E as part of PG&E's license or regulatory compliance.
- Send a letter requesting immediate in-depth seismic studies based on PG&E's and NRC's initial findings – do not tie to relicensing (parallel processes).
- 3. Send a letter requesting immediate in-depth seismic studies based on PG&E's initial findings request that additional studies be done prior to final relicensing.
