WHEREAS, Santa Barbara County employee moms have 13 dedicated County locations to express breast milk after returning to the workforce; and

WHEREAS, the theme for Breastfeeding Awareness Month 2010 is "Breastfeeding: Just 10 Steps! The Baby-Friendly Way"; and
