Recommended Actions:

Approve a contract between the County and the Cities of Lompoc, Santa Barbara and Santa Maria for library services for the period of July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011 for a total cost of \$2,978,640.67 for Fiscal Year 2010-11.

Summary Text:

On June 11, 2010, the Board of Supervisors adopted the Fiscal Year 2010-2011 Operating Budget, which included funding to the three cities of Santa Barbara, Lompoc and Santa Maria, known as Zones 1, 2 and 3 respectively, to provide library services to County residents. The approval of the proposed contract will authorize the County to contract with the cities for library services and funding for the period of July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011.

Background:

This item is on the Board's agenda in order to approve a new contract between the County and the Cities for library services and authorize the disbursement of funds to the cities for library services for Fiscal Year 2010-2011.

In the County, library services are provided via the Cities' main libraries and various branch locations as a way to efficiently use existing facilities and prevent the creation of county-operated duplicate establishments. The zones are as follows:

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• Zone 1: Santa Barbara is the contract city. Services provided to the cities and unincorporated area located within or in close proximity to Santa Barbara, Carpinteria, Montecito, Isla Vista, Goleta, Solvang, Santa Ynez and Los Olivos.

• Zone 2: Lompoc is the contract city. Services provided to the cities and unincorporated area located within or in close proximity to Buellton, Lompoc, Vandenberg Village and Vandenberg Air Force Base.

• Zone 3: Santa Maria is the contract city. Services provided to the cities and unincorporated area located within or in close proximity to Cuyama, Guadalupe, Orcutt and Santa Maria.

The County's contribution is based on the population figures for the cities and surrounding unincorporated area with each zone as certified for January 1st of each prior fiscal year by the California State Library.

In addition to the County contribution, Zone 1 also receives funding for the Goleta Area from CSA #3. CSA #3 is a voter approved measure to fund library services through a benefit assessment (which will be brought forward for Board of Supervisors approval as a separate agenda item).

In the course of Fiscal Year 2009-10 County staff met with City Zone Library Directors and the Library Advisory Committee and other interested stakeholders to identify areas for contract enhancements and refinement. For the upcoming contract year several items are proposed for inclusion:

- One year contract term.
- Provision of a 3-year Revenue Expenditure Plan including disclosures to the County regarding the use of reserves and gift monies at various branches.
- Establishment of a Gift Policy for each library zone.
- Alteration of Expenditure Plan and use of reserves must be reviewed with County Executive Office, impacted Branches and the Library Advisory Committee.
- Alteration of Hours of Operation and staffing at County Branches requires County Executive Office and Library Advisory Committee review. It should be noted that the City Library Directors have agreed that any city imposed furloughs or other closure would not impact branches in the unincorporated area in Fiscal Year 2010-11.

The libraries are required to report data to the State Library for its annual report entitled "California Library Statistics," of which some of the measures are included below:
