c) Implementing a salary increase of 22% for Forensic Technician classifications in the Sheriff's Department; and

d) Implementing a salary increase of 35% for the Polygraph Examiner classification in the Sheriff's Department;

e) Adopt a resolution effective April 9, 2007 implementing a salary increase of 10% for Environmental Health Specialist classifications in the Public Health Department; and

f) Implementing a salary increase of 5% for Hazardous Materials Specialist classifications in the Fire Department.
