b) Approve and authorize the Director of Planning and Development, or designee, to: extend performance in accordance with Section 3 of the contract for up to and not to exceed a period of one year for good cause; to terminate the contract in accordance with Section 4 and Section 15 of the contract for failure of Grantee to provide matching funds; and to approve project changes in accordance with Section 5 of the contract, including changes to project description, reduction in the overall project budget or change in a budget item of 10 percent or more; and

c) Determine that the allocation of the CREF grant for the excavation and restoration project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Section 15331 of the State Guidelines for the implementation of CEQA.
