b) Approve Budget Revision Request No. 0008871, appropriating \$67,120.00 in Grant Revenue and corresponding expenses for the initial 25% advance payment; and
c) Find that the proposed action does not constitute a "project" pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) guidelines, section 15738(b)(4), as it is the creation of a government funding mechanism or other government fiscal activity, which does not involve any commitment to any specific project which may result in a potentially significant physical impact on the environment.
