- a) Approve, ratify and authorize the Chair to execute an Agreement with the Community Health Centers of the Central Coast for the period of July 1, 2018 to June 30, 2019 to reimburse the Public Health Department for unused dental services of \$88,000.00 to be paid in four quarterly payments of \$22,000.00 each through Fiscal Year 2018-2019; and
