This Agreement is projected to generate approximately \$50,000.00 for the remainder of Fiscal Year 2013/2014 and up to \$200,000.00 revenue annually thereafter;

c) Approve Budget Revision Request No. 0003212 to amend the Fiscal Year 2013/2014 adopted budget for projected unanticipated revenue of \$50,000.00 for pharmaceuticals savings share revenues under the 340B Pharmacy Services Agreement with the Walgreens Company; and

d) Determine that these activities are exempt from California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) review per CEQA Guideline Section 15378(b)(4), since this is a government fiscal activity that does not involve commitment to a specific project that may result in a potentially significant physical impact on the environment.
