**Title:** Consider recommendations regarding a First Amendment, Fiscal Year (FY) 2017-2019, to Department of Health Care Services Contract for FEMA Grant Funded Crisis Counseling Services, as follows:

a) Approve, ratify and authorize the Director of Behavioral Wellness or designee to execute a first amendment to the multi-year revenue agreement No. 17-94705 with the state Department of Health Care Services, increasing Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) grant funds and extending the contract period by one month, for a new total contract amount of \$1,197,485.72 (inclusive of \$316,842.95 under the original agreement) for the period of January 15, 2018 through April 30, 2019; and

b) Determine that the above actions are government fiscal activities or funding mechanisms which do not involve any commitment to any specific project which may result in a potentially significant physical impact on the environment, and are therefore not a project under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to section 15378(b)(4) of the CEQA guidelines.
